

CURBSIDE YARD WASTE COLLECTION

- Yard Waste includes grass, leaves, limbs, trimmings, or other plant or vegetative material.
- Yard waste will be collected curbside every week on your yard waste service day. Material must be placed inside your yard waste cart with the lid able to close.
- Limbs must be no longer than 3 feet in length or greater than five (5) inches in diameter or greater than seventy-five (75) pounds in weight.
- Expanded leaf pick up will be provided during peak periods November 1st through January 15th. Please check the City of Dunn website for collection schedule.

CURBSIDE YARD WASTE COLLECTION

- Your new Yard Waste cart can be filled with leaves, grass and other trimmings from your property. Sticks and branches must be cut and placed into the can so that the lid will close when placed in the can.
- If you have a large limb or other yard debris that will not fit in the cart, please call the City of Dunn Public Works Department at (910) 892-2948 to request a curb side pick-up. The Public Works staff will evaluate your request and inform you of a potential pick-up date and if any disposal fees apply.
- As always, accommodations can be made for qualified persons with disabilities; contact *City of Dunn at (910)* 230-3510 for more details.
- Tree removal companies are responsible for removing all debris from any tree trimming activities.
- In the fall, The City will resume a bulk leaf pick-up schedule (November 1st January 15th). During this time, you are encouraged to continue to fill your yard waste can with leaves because it will reduce the wear and tear on the leaf vacuum truck.
