**2 – plastic bottles, glass bottles & jars, tin & aluminum cans**

**2 – newspaper & inserts**



Material	What Not to Recycle
<p><b>Newspaper</b> All newspaper and inserts</p>	<p>NO junk mail, catalogs or magazines</p>
<p><b>Plastics</b> Soda bottles (#1) Milk jugs (cloudy white, #2) Household consumables</p>	<p>NO other plastic containers or bottles NO plastic wrap or bags NO colored milk jugs NO sheet plastics or Plexiglas</p>
<p><b>Glass</b> All clear, brown, and green glass food or beverage containers</p>	<p>NO drinking glasses, crystal, light bulbs, mirrors, windows or dishes</p>
<p><b>Aluminum</b> Aluminum and tin beverage cans only</p>	<p>NO scrap metal, paint cans, aerosol cans, automotive product cans, aluminum foil or pie tins</p>
<p><b>Cardboard</b> corrugated cardboard only</p>	

- Recycling tips:

- Do NOT throw garbage/junk into bins – this contaminates load and will not be recycled.
- Do NOT throw whole plastic bags into bins.
- Plastics = bottle recycling (drink bottles, milk jugs (household consumables only))
- Please do NOT discard other plastic products or Plexiglas
- Glass = food or beverage containers
- Do NOT discard windows in bins.
