**SECTION IV. SPECIAL AUTHORIZATION-BUDGET OFFICER**

- A. The Budget Officer shall be authorized to affect interdepartmental transfers, in the same fund, not to exceed \$5,000.
- B. The Finance Director is hereby designated Finance Officer and is authorized to make interfund loans for a period of not more than 60 days. The Finance Officer shall establish and maintain accounting procedures which are in compliance with the Statutes of the State of North Carolina.
- C. Interfund transfers, established in the budget document, may be accomplished without recourse to the council.

**SECTION V. RESTRICTION-BUDGET OFFICER**

The interfund transfer of monies, except as noted in Section IV-paragraph B and C, shall be accomplished by Council authorization only.

**SECTION VI. UTILIZATION OF BUDGET AND BUDGET ORDINANCE**

The Ordinance and the Budget Document, shall be the basis of the financial plan for the Dunn Municipal Government during the 2013-14 fiscal year. The Budget Officer shall administer the budget and shall insure that the operating facilities are provided guidance and sufficient details to implement their appropriate portion of the Budget.

**SECTION VII. DISTRIBUTION**

Copies of this Ordinance shall be furnished to the Clerk, to the Council, and to the Budget Officer and Finance Director to be kept on file by them for their direction in the disbursement of funds.
