**POLITICAL SIGN AGREEMENT FORM**

The following conditions are listed for the convenience of the political sign permit applicant. By signing this form, the applicant states that they are in full understanding of the requirements and will follow these requirements. (*Dunn City Code Sec. 22-291(3) and Sec. 22-296*)

**Residential Areas:** Political signs may be located in the vicinity of a polling place for a period not to exceed twenty-four (24) hours preceding the opening of polls. The signs shall contain a maximum of four (4) square feet per side of sign area and be located at a height not to exceed forty-two (42) inches. Only one (1) political sign per parcel or tract of land per candidate is allowed.

**Political Sign:** Signs of political candidates' parties or groups supporting the candidacy of any individual for office or waging public support of, or opposition to, any public issues to be voted upon. Permits for such signs are allowed with the following conditions:

- Permit is applied for with a deposit of \$150.00, which shall be returned, less the permit fee of \$75.00, after all signs have been removed. If the signs are not removed within five (5) days after election day, the deposit shall be retained by the city by deducting \$10.00 for each day the signs remain up.
- No sign shall exceed sixteen square feet per side, thirty-two (32) square feet in total aggregate. Signs shall not exceed forty-eight inches in height. All signs not attached to building structures shall be self-supporting.
- Time limit:
  - Primary: political signs shall be placed no more than forty-five (45) days before one stop early voting begins and shall be removed within five (5) days after the primary.
  - General Election: political signs shall be placed no more than forty-five (45) days before one-stop early voting begins and shall be removed within five (5) days after the general election.
- No more than one political sign per candidate is allowed on any tract or parcel of land.
- All candidates shall be issued one political sign permit per election year.
- Political signs shall meet all additional requirements imposed in this division.
